Brdr. Krüger collaborates with some of the world's best minds in design, art and architecture to create an evolving furniture of collection.



HB Lounge Chair

Although Hans Bølling has been responsible for several iconic Danish designs over the decades, he has never before created a lounge chair - until now.

Natural linen canvas is used for the seat, back and armrests, suspended as the soft counterpart to a pared back, almost architectural base in solid wood.

The HB Lounge Chair is made for comfort, to please the eye and to complement or complete interior settings with its carefully calibrated material, shape and functionality. HB Lounge Chair is created from the philosophy of design honesty, which characterizes Bølling's unique style. His work is based on traditional joinery and sensible solutions, which are so beautiful that they deserve to be highlighted.

Bølling is a master in his field, and from his pure approach emerges timeless design that can appeal across generations.

Available in Oak or Cherry, with stainless steel details, natural linen, and optional Brandy leather cushions.

HB Stool


Hans Bølling extends his HB collection with a compelling smaller piece in the shape of a stool that can be used as footstool for the HB Lounge Chair or used on its own as occasional seating in the living room, entrance or bedroom.

The HB Stool embodies Bølling's signature, distinguished by a calm style, sound craftsmanship and beautiful detailing that exudes unique harmony. Natural linen canvas is used for the seat, suspended as the soft counterpart to a pared back, almost architectural base in solid wood.

HB Stool is available in Oak and Cherry wood, with natural linen and optional Brandy leather cushion.







HB Coffee Table

The new HB Coffee Table is a natural evolvement of Bølling's design legacy, with a clear focus on usability and subtle signature detailing.

His new design draw on the essentials of his iconic Tray Table from 1963, today considered a heritage piece, yet the dimensions and usability have adapted to its new role as centre table. The design is clean, subtle and timeless in the spirit of Danish Modernism. The linear structure interreacts with the soft round tabletop and the characterful wooden veneer frame that runs along the edge of the table.

The HB Coffee Table is available in Oak and Cherry wood and can be used in living rooms, lounge settings or lobby areas.





Jari Low Tables



Brdr. Krüger has collaborated with long-term design partners OEO Studio to create a series of coffee and side tables in solid certified oak.


The series consists of two different tabletop shapes in variations of six sizes and heights. The tabletops are designed as organic ellipses and circles with soft edges. The legs have narrowing profiles for a light appearance. With the thoughtful and well-proportioned shapes, sizes and heights, the Jari Low Tables can be used in a multitude of settings, on its own or in groups, in any living room, lounge setting, lobby area or hotel room.

The fluid and compelling design can reduce uniformity and bring any space to life.














Arv Lounge

Brdr. Krüger has collaborated with David Thulstrup to create a lounge chair version of the acclaimed and award-winning Arv Chair, initially designed for restaurant Noma.

Thulstrup seeks to balance beauty with durability, lightness with comfort, and materials that will only become more expressed over time. The well-proportioned shapes and refined detailing are based on the fundamental idea of seamless joinery, reflecting organic growth patterns found in nature. Arv Lounge Chair enriches interior settings with timeless appeal and quality, fitting for hospitality settings, low-seat office areas, or private residences.

Arv Lounge is available in oiled or fumed oak, combined with handwaved paper cord. The surfaces are hand-polished with natural wax oil, providing a protective layer with a soft touch.





Arkade Chair

Nanna Ditzel's love for interior decoration is fully articulated in the Arkade Chair. It embodies Ditzel's bold character and expressive design signature with its elegant geometries and comfortable shapes.

The vision of Arkade Chair is expressed through its recurring circles and arches, hence the name Arkade (the Danish word for Arcade) with a nod to classic architecture. The techniques and materials going into the making of the Arkade Chair includes solid wood steam-bending, woodturning, precise steelwork in various finishes and, not least full upholstery in textile or leather.

All components of the chair can be configured, inviting for a personal touch and adaptability to interior contexts.

Arkade Chair was initially designed in 1983 during a decadelong collaboration between the late Ditzel and Brdr. Krüger, and was the first time put into production in 2020.





Arv Chair

The award-winning Arv chair draws on the classic virtues of Danish Modern design with timeless qualities, yet it has the spirit of a new generation.

The design takes its inspiration from the seamless organic shapes found in nature, implemented in the smooth joinery that gives the chair a subtle wholeness.

Beneath the chair's seamless appearance lies many complex design details pushing the limits of quality craftsmanship. The Arv chair is an uncompromised piece of Danish heritage design.

The Arv Collection was initially developed for the new internationally acclaimed Noma restaurant in Copenhagen.

The solid wood backrest, with optional paper cord, brings contrast and materiality. The seat is available in classic danish paper cord or upholstered in textile or leather.

Arv Table

Brdr. Krüger has collaborated with David Thulstrup on a new collection of furniture pieces for the new Noma restaurant in Copenhagen titled the Arv Collection.

It comprises chairs and tables that are part of Brdr. Krüger's core collection.

The Arv chair is classic yet contemporary in aesthetic, with a timeless quality. It draws on iconic traditional Danish design yet has the spirit of a new generation.

Beneath the chair's seemingly simple aesthetic lies a multitude of complex design details that push the conventional limits of craftsmanship.

The conceptual design feature is a 'branch' formation that organicalzly connects the different parts – like branches growing from a tree trunk. The process to materialise the branching design of the chair is a highly complex one, but Brdr. Krüger made no compromises to realise the true vision.

F Chair

F Chair is a modern take on the centuries-old farmhouse archetype chair. It carries on the honest and folksy origin yet offers a modern pared-back take on the classic typology and, not least improved good comfort.

Danish experimental designer Rasmus Fex has explored both traditions and new materials with an open mind, and the outcome is a new timeless, durable and useable chair. F Chair is available with- or without armrests. The oak wood is available in natural oil or ash in various lacquered colours.

The hand-weaved seat is available in natural linen webbing or classic paper cord - or matching colors from recycled polypropylene whitch is resilient and suitable for public environments.

The unique seamless joinery in the backrest and the new seat pattern makes F Chair both fit in and stand out.

















Pauline Bar Stool



With its subtle details and attuned personality, Pauline Bar Stools tell the story of craftsmanship shaped by contemporary sensibility. The subtle design and comfortable dimensions make it suitable for both domestic and professional use, where uncompromising quality is imperative.

Pauline is designed for versatility. Each component of the chair is designed from modular thinking, offering a wider spectrum of configurations. Thomas Lykke of OEO Studio says: "The simple construction and look of Pauline has been accomplished by combining thoughtfulness with craftsmanship".

The base is made from either wood or metal in various finishes. The seat is made from solid wood and upholstery. It comes complete with a fully upholstered backrest in textile or leather. The chairs are availbale in three seat heights.

Jari Chair

The Jari Chair is part of the Jari Collection, whitch also contains various Tables, and was initially developed as a signature pieces for the two-starred Michelin restaurant INUA in Tokyo - an outpost of the Noma restaurant.

Jari Chair seeks to embed the shared cultural values of Japanese and Danish design, defined as an appreciation of good craftsmanship and a close connection with nature.





Jari Table


The award-winning Jari table stands apart from conventional design. The organic and ellipsee-inspired shape is designed to accommodate enhanced social presence.

Each table features deep, double-rounded soft edges, offering a floating appearance and representing a tactile connection to nature.

The Jari takes its name from the Japanese word meaning 'pebbles' - and draws inspiration from natural beach pebbles that have been slowly rounded by lapping waves over centuries. Soft and subtle asymmetric shapes characterise the JARI chair and table. Like a Japanese Zen garden, JARI seeks to reflect a simplified version of nature and create space for a sense of calmness and timelessness.

TRIIIO Tables


In 1958 Danish architect Hans Bølling made a remarkable design, with a playful construction that establishes a poetic harmony between the functional and the sculptural.

The addition of tinted glass and accents in brass gives the table a compelling finish and modern touch with international reference. The TRIIIO tables are well-crafted with high precision and delicate details. The thoughtful construction enbables the product to be shipped flat-pack.

Hans Bølling is uniquely capable of unfolding rational structures into highly aesthetic design.

The TRIIIO table series consists of three table sizes, each with its purpose; Coffee, side and dining table.





Bølling Tray Table

In 1963 Danish Architect Hans Bølling designed a simple and highly functional table, which was knockdown, easy to assemble and easy to handle. The Bølling Tray Table is today considered a Danish classic and owes its wide-reaching success to its clean lines, but emotional and playful qualities.


The Bølling Tray Table reflects perfectly Brdr. Krüger's design philosophy: to craft honest and original designs that are built to last.

It is flexible and versatile, serving as a trolley or side table. The two reversible trays can be turned for colour variation, and there is a wide range to choose from.

The Bølling Tray Table is available in two different dimensions and serves its purposes in both private and public spaces.

It is shipped knock-down in a flat pack, reducing its footprint in transportation.

Karm Sofa

Brdr. Krüger, has collaborated with David Thulstrup on the Karm sofa series, which was originally developed as a bespoke piece for the lounge of the new Noma restaurant in Copenhagen.

Made from a special selection of characteristic old oak timber, the sofa's nostalgic design evokes a sense of honesty and simplicity. 'The design concept is based on a sense of Scandinavian locality yet avoids clichés', says Thulstrup. The clean, modern lines make it a sophisticated reminiscent of past Danish design.

The Karm sofas feature signature Brdr. Krüger detailing and skilfully handcrafted woodwork, exemplified in the delicate wedge joints, visible on both sides of the piece.

The sofas are available in 1, 2 and 3 seaters. Both wood and fabrics are customizable upon request.

Ferdinand Lounge



The vision for Ferdinand was to create a signature design for Brdr. Krüger that reflects contemporary sensibilities while honouring the legacy of 20th-century design.

Woodturning is a key element of the structural design, a technique that combines classic craftsmanship with modern manufacturing methods.

The result is a bold and distinctive design with the backrest and frame effortlessly fusing together. With two centuries of design tradition coming together in one composition, the lounge chair is named after one Ferdinand, one of the founding Krüger brothers, five generations back.

Ferdinand has its own distinctive character. The interaction between material, form and functionality endows Ferdinand with an essential simplicity and sophisticated luxury that has deep roots in a Scandinavian mindset but maintains an international appeal.





Lune Lamp

Lune Lamp is a playful fusion of traditional woodturning and new technology. The result is a modern lamp with a tactile and welcoming feel.

The thin and delicate spheric shade is made from solid wood, carefully turned to perfection. Lune Lamp is the meeting of seemingly simple profiles, refined by quality materials and skilful craftsmanship. Lune Lamp gives a soft local light, suitable for both home and office.

The name Lune refers to the Scandinavian word for warm, cosy, reflecting the basic human need for furniture that make us feel comfortable and at ease.

Lune is available as both table and pendant lamp.
